Attendees' numbers are limited to ensure individual attention is provided; this is underpinned by assessments & case studies at different stages throughout the course(s) to ensure understanding. **Day 1 UKATA Asbestos Safety Awareness & the Regs (recognised competence)**

The aims & objectives of day 1 are to ensure knowledge and understanding of what, why & where asbestos can be found by illustrative photographs, sealed samples & video footage, includes the associated health risks with asbestos exposure. It provides the legislative framework for licensed asbestos, covering CDM 2015, Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012, L143 (2<sup>nd</sup> edition ACOP) HSG264 Asbestos survey & NNLW (notifiable non-licensed work).

Attendees will understand the various types of asbestos, typical products, the range of hazards including health risks, an understanding of the legislation, duties, good practice, and precautions needed, PPE & RPE with an introduction to air testing & waste disposal.

**Day 2 Duty to Manage & Controlling Work with Asbestos (recognised competence)**

The aims & objectives of day 2 are to develop understanding of the HSE asbestos surveying guidance HSG 264 & L143 2<sup>nd</sup> edit / HSG 227 by undertaking a virtual survey, identifying likely asbestos & risk assessing the asbestos materials. Options of leaving, treating, or removing asbestos is explored with "costs –v– benefits" to determine the appropriate course of action with management & controls under various circumstances. Plus practical guidance on HSG 247 Licensed Contractors Guide, CIRIA, Cl:aire contaminated land and the NEW HSG 248 Analysts guide (latest revision July 2021) stressing the importance of (4SC) visual inspections, photographic records, air testing & Certificate for Re-occupation.

Attendees will interpret an asbestos survey report, be able to specify, procure the correct asbestos survey and decide on the appropriate actions to be undertaken. They will also have an appreciation of the planning, notification, working, air testing & disposal of asbestos demonstrating competence to specify, appoint & work of licensed asbestos contractors to ensure safe effective controls are in place.
